Re: Survivair Acid Gas, Multi-contaminant, Multi-contaminant / P100, and Hydrogen Chloride Cartridges manufactured in 2002.

Hydrogen chloride and formaldehyde analyzers used by Survivair to perform lot acceptance service life tests in year 2002 may have been out of calibration. There is no indication that this caused any kind of problem with the quality of the cartridges, but we want to locate cartridges made in 2002 and perform tests to assure that they meet our specifications for cartridge service life. We are trying to locate samples of the following model cartridges that have 2002 date codes.

If you have any of the above Survivair cartridges with a date code that shows it was made in year 2002, please contact Survivair Technical services at 1-800-394-0410 to arrange to return the cartridges for testing. Survivair will pay for shipping and will provide new replacement cartridges at no charge.

Please see the photograph located on the second page of this safety notice to assist you in identifying the manufacturing date code on Survivair cartridges.

We appreciate your help in this matter. Again there is no indication of any kind of problem with these products. There have been no complaints or tests failures. But we are uncertain of the calibration status of the hydrogen chloride and formaldehyde analyzers used for lot acceptance testing during year 2002 and need to verify that the products meet our service life specifications when tested with calibrated analyzers.

The photograph above shows the date code from a Survivair model 1058 cartridge. It illustrates the location of the date code on the label. The third and fourth digits from the left in the code pictured above indicate the year that the cartridge was manufactured. The 03 in 21031A indicates that the cartridge shown in this photograph was manufactured in 2003. We are looking for cartridges manufactured in 2002 and therefore are looking for cartridges marked with 02 stamped in this location.
