PORTABLE TEST CONSOLE UPGRADE, P/N 905790

A major improvement has been made to Survivair's Portable Test Console.

The primary feature is the 0" to 4" H₂O magnahelic pressure gauge used to set lock-up or static facepiece pressure. The new gauge has finer incremental settings (10 to an inch) and has the advantage of a full four inch sweep.

A positive/negative switch has also been added to the console to allow negative or positive pressure readings to be recorded.

All new systems are sold in this configuration. For those who would like to upgrade their older models, the following information will be of help:

1. Conversions must be made by Survivair, Santa Ana.
2. Units sent in for conversion will be completed within 10 days after receipt. The price is \$199.00 plus \$17.00 handling.
3. We suggest you consider having a conversion done during your yearly calibration. This would give you a savings of \$140.00 by eliminating added labor charges and handling, since a conversion includes a calibration.

We strongly recommend warranty repair centers upgrade their test consoles, since the new configuration enhances setting accuracy and results in time savings for the technician.
